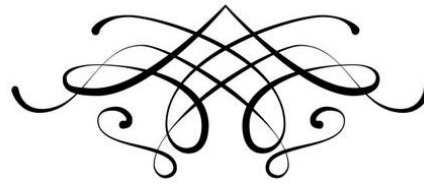

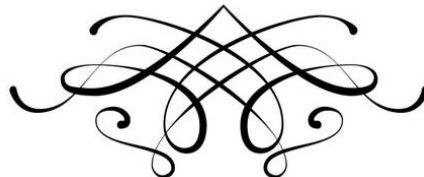

OUR MISSION

Who's Eligible:

All persons assisted by ROSS Service Coordinators must be residents of Conventional public housing which include:

- **Family:** Anyone that resides in the public housing unit except live-in Aide
- **Elderly:** Age 62 & older
- **Disabled:** Person with disabilities by HUD/Social Security definition
